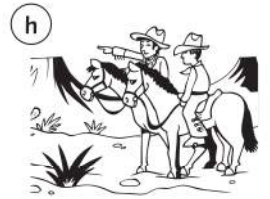

A new tennis star

Rafael Nadal is a tennis player. He was born in Manacor, Mallorca, in 1986. He ¹ *started* playing tennis with his uncle Toni, who is his coach, when he was four years old, and he ² _____ his first championship when he ³ _____ eight years old.

He ⁴ _____ his career as a professional tennis player in 2001 when he ⁵ _____ his first ATP (Association of Tennis Professionals) match in Mallorca at fifteen years old. In April 2005, he ⁶ _____ one of the top ten players in the ATP after winning the Open Seat Godo competition in Barcelona. In the same year, he also ⁷ _____ the Brazil Open, the ATP Masters Series in Monte Carlo and Rome, and the Mexican Open.

In July 2008, Nadal ⁸ _____ Roger Federer to win the Wimbledon Championships in London. In 2011, he ⁹ _____ the World Sportsman of the Year. After winning the 2014 French open, he ¹⁰ _____ the only male player ever to win a single Grand Slam tournament nine times.
